
TANZANIA, UNFORGETTABLE

SERENGETI

Serengeti is home to the Maasai people, which means “endless plains”. Serengeti National Park is the first of its kind in Tanzania, inscribed as UNESCO World Heritage in 1981.

Serengeti is known to the world by its amazing fauna and flora, and spectacular natural views. One of nature’s most marvelous scenes, the Great Wildebeest Migration, follows a certain pattern every year around the Serengeti. Serengeti National Park also hosts “The Big Five” – Lion, Elephant, Leopard, Black Rhino, and African Buffalo, and many more species, making it the ultimate destination for safaris.





NGORONGORO

Ngorongoro Conservation Area is Africa's first UNESCO World Heritage in the Mixed (both natural and cultural) category. Its core, the Ngorongoro Crater, is the world's largest inactive, intact and unfilled volcanic caldera.

A large number of large animals live in the crater, including lions, African buffalos, hippos, and black rhinos. The diversity of flora at different altitudes of the crater, together with the mist that lingers around the edge, truly presents the beauty of the nature that one can't miss.





LAKE MANYARA

Situated in the Great Rift Valley, Lake Manyara is famous for birdwatching. In the wet seasons, thousands of flocks of flamingos would gather around the lake.



TARANGIRE

Tarangire National Park is famous for its high density of elephants and baobab trees. It is also habitat for various predators and birds.

Tarangire and Lake Manyara National Parks are ideal for short safari trips thanks to their proximity to Arusha city and relatively smaller sizes.






MT. KILIMANJARO

Standing at 5,895 meters above sea level, Mt. Kilimanjaro is the highest peak of Africa, as well as the highest free-standing peak on the planet. The best time to climb Mt. Kilimanjaro is the cool and dry season from June to October, as well as lush but not yet quite rainy period between December and March. Because Mt. Kilimanjaro is a tropical high-altitude mountain, people can experience different vegetations and climate when ascending to the peak.

Kilimanjaro National Park was inscribed as UNESCO World Heritage in 1987.






ZANZIBAR

Zanzibar Archipelago is like pearls in the western Indian Ocean. With its long history of trading ties with the Arab world, the capital Stone Town preserves great architectural and cultural legacies from the ancient time, and therefore was inscribed as a UNESCO World Heritage site. The culture of Zanzibar is a unique mix of African, Islamic and Indian influences.

Zanzibar also produces varieties of spices, including cloves, nutmeg, cinnamon and black pepper. The white beaches and water sports around the island make it a paradise for a relaxing vacation.

THE GREAT MIGRATION

Every year, up to 1.5 million of wildebeests migrate alongside 200 thousand zebras, 350 thousand gazelles and 12 thousand elands. This strange wonder of the natural world circulates the Serengeti National Park with its path dictated by rainfall and the resulting growth of grasses on the plains. The precise timing of the migration is entirely dependent upon the rainfall patterns each year.

For any visitor to the Serengeti, the wildlife spectacle of the migration offers a huge enhancement to what is already an overwhelming sight.




GETTING HERE


